**PRINCETON** -- Princeton resident Nancy Beck, who recently received the 18th annual Leslie "Bud" Vivian Award for Community Service from Princeton Area Community Foundation, will be publicly celebrated at Dorothea House in Princeton on Sept. 28. at 1 p.m.

The Vivian Award for Community Service, established by members of the Princeton University class of 1942, recognizes a person who exemplifies the late Bud Vivian's commitment to serve the whole of the Princeton community.

Beck gives generously of her time to a wide array of Princeton-area nonprofit organizations. Her longest and most sustaining contribution is to the Princeton Adult School, where she served as a member of its board for more than 25 years and as its president for more than 10. In addition to supervising the creation and management of

the entire Adult School curriculum, she has been instrumental in creating two high profile lecture series and finding eminent scholar or nationally prominent experts to share their knowledge.

Beck also reads each week at Learning Ally, is on the board of Dorothea House and is a former trustee of the Stony Brook-Millstone Watershed Association.

Princeton Area Community Foundation promotes philanthropy across central New Jersey by providing charitable giving expertise to individuals, organizations and corporations and making grants to nonprofit organizations. The community service award is made possible through the Vivian Memorial Fund, an endowment fund of the Princeton Area Community Foundation.

The public is invited to celebrate Beck and her award at Dorothea House, located at 120 John Street, Princeton.
